

Term 4 Coaches, Managers and Volunteers

Kia ora te Whānau,

On Monday, 25 October the [COVID-19 Public Health Response Order for Mandatory Vaccinations for Education](#) came into effect. Everyone who works for a school or kura, external providers and volunteers who have contact with children or students or will be present at a time when children and students are also present will be required to have a first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine by 15 November 2021 and be fully vaccinated by 1 January 2022.

- As a first step and with pace, all NZ Schools have been instructed to evidence that people working onsite or offsite with children in Term 4 must have received their first vaccination by 15 November 2021.
- **Below outlines the Pāpāmoa Primary School process for all coaches, managers, volunteers and external personnel to follow. This will allow you to work with, coach or manage Pāpāmoa Primary School students on or offsite.** We will confidentially collect and store the vaccination status submitted by the above people and organisations.
- Please do feel free to contact me if you have any queries. Thank you for the quick sharing of your first vaccine information and your understanding of the importance of this.

Regular and 'One off' Volunteers, Coaches and Managers Term 4 2021

- **If you are vaccinated (at least 1 x shot) before 15 November 2021** please provide us with evidence of your initial vaccination [CLICK HERE](#)
 - Evidence we accept (1mb file size max) via the above link of your first vaccination includes immunisation card, or vaccination statement from [My Covid Record](#). If there is a medical reason why you cannot be vaccinated, you are not required to meet this mandate, however you will need to provide evidence of your exemption from a suitably qualified health practitioner.
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- **If you won't be vaccinated by 15 November 2021 and you are already assisting, coaching or managing** please email admin@papamoa.school.nz as soon as possible. This will enable us to find a person to cover your role from Tuesday 16 November 2021 through until the end of the term, if required.

Additional Reminders:

Here is the [Level 2 Parent Letter](#) sent on 10 July 2021 that outlines the Papamoa Primary School Level 2 guidelines. Being mindful of reducing risk, local schools are now needing to limit the need for and number of external visitors/parents onsite. An update of our planned activities for Term 4 which were to have a large number of parent helpers and/or visitors onsite are outlined below. We do love having families and visitors onsite for our events, but caution is needed at this time.

Term 4 Events:

- **Term 4 Sports Teams** - We ask all adults/visitors on the Papamoa Primary School site to wear masks, only coaches and managers can take masks off during training.
- **Week 5 - Jump Jam Challenge** - Finals are now a video entry which will be shared with our parent community.
- **Week 5 - Road Patroller Training and Bike Safety Training** - Year 5/6 Students - TBC. If going ahead this will be with a set minimal number of NZ Police and Tauranga City Council staff onsite following our Level 2 protocols.
- **Week 5-7 - Athletics Fundays** - In school only. No spectators allowed.
- **Week 6 - Road Patrollers Orange Day Parade** - Banner competition and shared lunch at Papamoa Primary School.
- **Week 6-8 - Deep Water Survival** - Whole School - all parent volunteers will need to have had their first vaccination by 15 November 2021.
- **Week 8 - New Entrant Visits** - Parents to meet Deputy Principal Fay Warnock at the junior gate. Signing in on the register and mask wearing is required. Parents will need to have had their first vaccination by 15 November 2021 in order to remain on-site for the school visits. Further information will be provided to these parents.
- **Week 9 - Kapa Haka Roopu** - Practises are held outside with social distancing. Video will be shared.
- **Week 9 - Year 6 Leavers Assembly** - Student/Staff only assembly. We are aiming to livestream. Senior class teachers will provide parents with further information.
- **End of Year Pod Celebrations** - On site, manageable without parent volunteers and following Level protocols.
